➔ The subject's record reflects a serious and escalating pattern spanning 15 years. The 2019 third-degree murder conviction (aid/abet, drug distribution) and the 2024 felony weapons conviction — possessing a dangerous weapon in a courthouse — are the most critical indicators for recovery agents. The 2023 second-degree drug possession (25+ grams cocaine/methamphetamine) and the felony fleeing conviction confirm ongoing high-risk behavior. Multiple probation terms are active or recently active, and the subject was under court jurisdiction as recently as June 2024. No explicit FTA records are present in the data, but the volume and severity of felony convictions warrants elevated caution.

⊖ The subject presents a high threat profile. The 2024 courthouse weapons conviction confirms active willingness to carry in restricted, law-enforcement-heavy environments — recovery agents should vest up and treat every approach as potentially armed. The felony fleeing conviction indicates the subject will not voluntarily comply and may attempt vehicle or foot flight. Substance involvement at the distribution/possession level suggests potential for erratic, volatile behavior. A minimum two-agent team with law enforcement notification is strongly recommended prior to any apprehension attempt.

Primary: 4321 Columbia Ave, Saint Paul, MN 55104 — most recent address, active since Aug 2022, deliverable, non-public (private listing). Longest continuous address tenure in recent history. Attempt early morning (6–8 AM) before subject is mobile.

Secondary: 9876 Hudson St NE, Minneapolis, MN 55418 — mother Patricia Holloway's confirmed residence; subject's address history shows prior association with this address. High harboring probability.

Tertiary: 345 24th Ave NE, Unit 20, Minneapolis, MN 55418 — associate Marcus Briggs's current address; subject previously listed this address in her own history.

Check: 4321 Columbia Ave, Saint Paul, MN 55104 — address on active professional license; possible daytime work location.

🚗 Mobility Patterns

Residence pattern: Subject's primary address (Saint Paul) has been stable since mid-2022. Homemaker license work is unscheduled, suggesting irregular daytime movement. Early morning attempts at the Saint Paul address are most likely to find the subject present. No current vehicle on record — subject may rely on others for transportation, increasing likelihood of being found at residence.

⚖️ Legal Leverage

Active probation: Subject is under Hennepin County Community Corrections supervision on multiple felony probation terms (2023 drug/theft convictions; 2024 weapons conviction). Probation officer contact may compel surrender or provide current check-in address.

Professional license: Active Homemaker/Healthcare license (license ID on file) — license revocation risk may be a surrender incentive.

Civil judgment: Outstanding judgment by Credit Acceptance Corporation (filed Dec 2022, Case 27CV22334455) — financial pressure may be leveraged in surrender negotiations.

Prior bail history: 2017 murder arrest resulted in \$100,000 bail; subject was released on bond and conditional release — bond history confirms prior bail system involvement.

7. Final Thoughts

➡ The recommended primary apprehension location is 4321 Columbia Ave, Saint Paul — the subject's longest-held recent address, deliverable, and privately listed, suggesting active habitation. Optimal window is early morning (6–8 AM) on weekdays before the subject is mobile. The absence of a current registered vehicle suggests the subject may be dependent on associates for transportation, increasing the probability of finding her at the residence.

The secondary priority is the mother's address at 9876 Hudson St NE, Minneapolis, followed by associate Marcus Briggs's address at 345 24th Ave NE. Both represent credible harboring locations given documented address overlap.

The recovery team must treat this subject as armed and dangerous. The 2024 courthouse weapons conviction — carrying in a law-enforcement-controlled environment — is the single most critical officer-safety indicator. Vest up, minimum two agents, and notify local law enforcement prior to approach per applicable state rules. Substance involvement at the distribution level introduces volatility risk. The felony fleeing conviction confirms the subject will not surrender passively — a perimeter approach is advisable. Flight out of state appears unlikely given active probation supervision and local family network, but cannot be excluded.
